TITLE: Medical Gas Permit and Verifier

TOPIC: Plumbing

**SUMMARY:** This policy memo implements the NFPA Health Care Facilities Code by

clearly delineating the types of uses requiring a Verifier, Medical Gas Permit,

and/or Placard.

## **POLICY:**

Section 1301.0 (*Medical gas plan review and permits*), codified in LDC § 25-12-153 (*Local Amendments to Uniform Plumbing Code*), requires properly engineered plans for medical gas systems designed for human uses. Based on risk categories delineated by the NFPA Health Care Facilities Code, the following table specifies types of uses requiring a Verifier, Medical Gas Permit, and/or Placard for identification purposes:
