The Austin Water Utility's water distribution system has approximately 3,000 miles of water mains, 65,000 valves, 30,000 fire hydrants, and 200,000 water service connections.

This construction service agreement is a pilot project to assist the Utility in expediting the repair of water mains and other sources of water leaks in the distribution system during peak and emergency conditions when the Utility's own field crews are at their maximum production capacity.

When needed, this construction service agreement will provide for repairs to the Austin Water Utility's water distribution system at various locations throughout the system. This will include repairing water mains, replacing leaking water services, and repairing/replacing water valves
