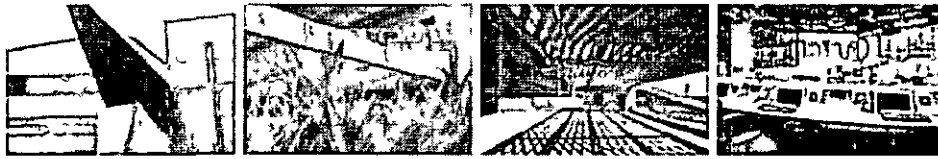

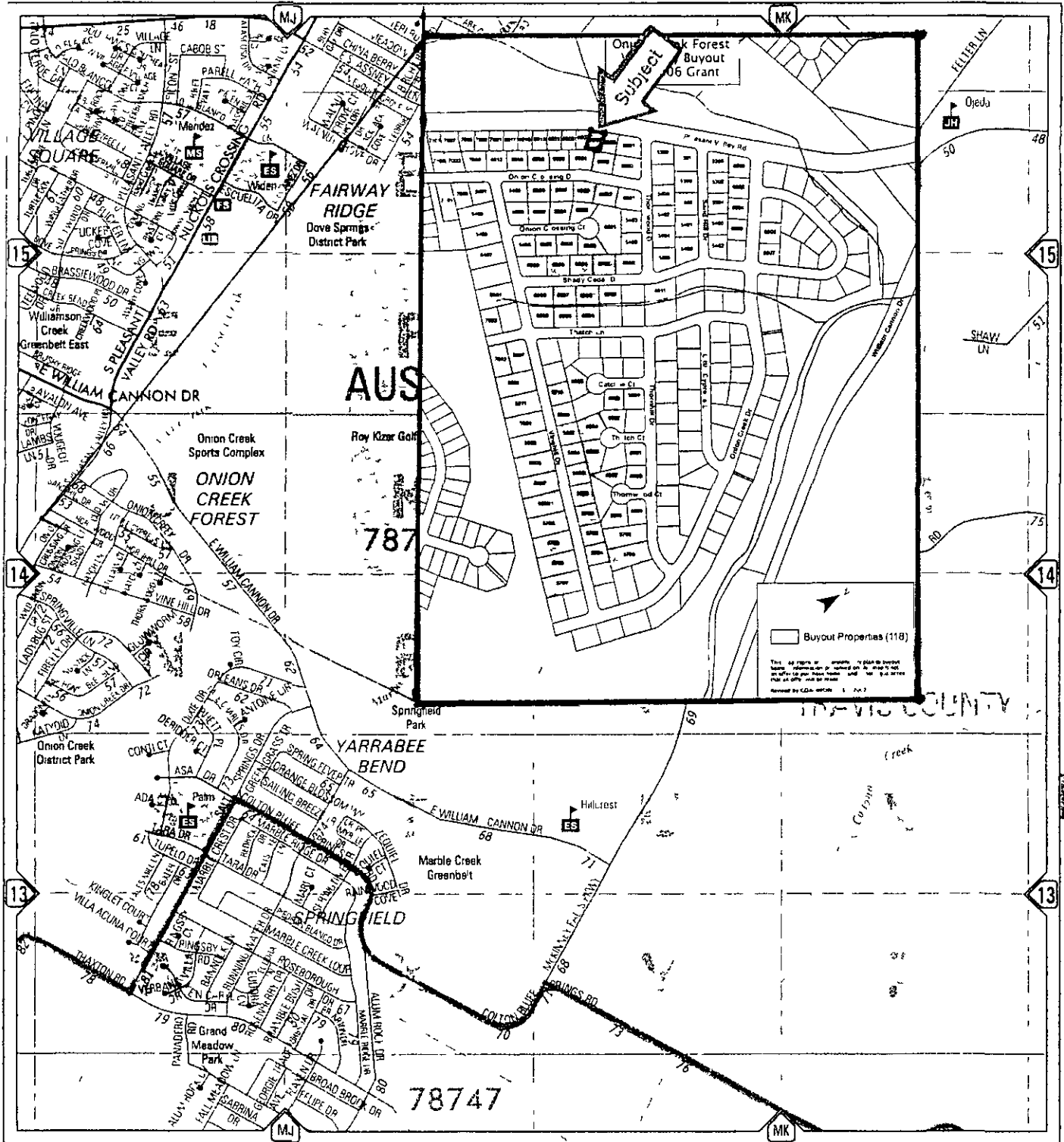
On July 27, 2006, Council approved and accepted \$6,255,823 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Onion Creek Voluntary Flood Buyout-FEMA-1606-DR Project. The purpose of the project is to purchase and demolish up to 118 single-family structures in the floodplain of Onion Creek, an area significantly impacted during the floods of October 17, 1998 and November 15, 2001, and maintain the land as open space. The property and residence located at 6903 South Pleasant Valley Road are part of the approved grant program.

The lot to be acquired is approximately 0.16 acres with improvements that include a 1,648 square foot single-family dwelling. The market value of the property including improvements is \$100,000, as determined by independent appraisal. The owner has agreed to accept the City's offer. The City will relocate those displaced by the project according to the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended.

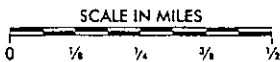
