MBE/WBE This contract was awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) No subcontracting opportunities were identified, therefore, no goals were established for this contract

Prior Council Action 3/29/01- approved original contract for the purchase of a computer aided dispatch system

This contract amendment will provide for the installation and testing of a back-up computer aided dispatch system (CAD) for the Emergency Operation Center, including additional licenses and maintenance. The existing system, located at the Combined Transportation, Emergency and Communications Center (CTECC), provides information to 9-1-1 call takers, dispatchers, and supervisors for the Austin Police Department, Austin Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services, and the Travis County Sheriff's Office. The system allows users to track calls, direct resources, and monitor activities related to providing emergency services. The back-up system will be located at an off-site backup facility. It will be activated if CTECC is not usable due to natural disasters or if CTECC experiences unnatural disasters such as power failures, terrorist attacks, or plane crashes. The back-up system will help to ensure minimal interruption of emergency services.
