

## ***ADDENDUM***

If necessary, the City Council may go into a closed session as permitted by law regarding any item on this agenda.

#### **ITEMS FROM COUNCIL**

48. Direct the City Manager to facilitate public input regarding the establishment of a community development program for the area of East Austin bounded by I-35 from Manor Road to Riverside Drive, Riverside Drive from I-35 to SH 71, SH 71 from Riverside Drive to US 183, US 183 from SH71 to Manor Road, and Manor Road from US 183 to I-35; and based on this input make recommendations to City Council on the implementation of the program. 49. Discuss legal issues regarding the full purpose annexation of the Greenshores Area (approximately 176.8 acres located in Travis County approximately one mile east of the intersection of City Park Road and Pearce Road).
