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



This construction contract will provide for the installation of new wastewater and water pipeline in the area bordered by Barton Springs Road to the north Kinney Avenue to the west Lamar Boulevard to the east and Nash Street to the south Additional impacted streets include Hillmont Street Bluff Street Juliet Street Ethel Street Jesse Street Josephine Street Treadwell Street and Collier Street The proposed improvements include the installation of 6 300 feet of 8 inch wastewater line 1 585 feet of 12 inch wastewater line 175 feet of 6 inch water line 5 150 feet of 8 inch water line and 61 new wastewater manholes The improvements will replace aging and deteriorated facilities and eliminate wastewater overflows that have occurred in this area. The project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP) which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows

Due to the potential for conflicts when installing underground utilities and for unknown subsurface conditions while working in the street right of way a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 340 calendar days for substantial completion and another 30 calendar days for final completion of this project.



Bid documents were distributed to eight general contractors Bids were opened January 4 2007 Laughlin Thyssen Inc submitted the lowest of four bids received
