In November 2003 the City entered into a construction contract with Archer Western Contractors Inc for construction of the Ullrich Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Expansion to 160 MGD (million gallons per day) – Contract 3 Project in the amount of \$60 852 810 The construction contract included installation of equipment prepurchased by the City from seven vendors. The dollar value of the prepurchased equipment was \$9 625 020

The contract required that Archer Western Contractors meet five Interim Contractual milestones with a substantial completion to be achieved by February 8 2006 and final completion of the project by May 9 2006 Archer Western Contractors failed to meet four of the five Interim Contractual Milestones and the substantial and final completion dates required by the original schedule. Subsequently, the City had demanded that Archer Western Contractors substantially complete the project by September 15, 2006, and to finally complete the Project by December 15, 2006. Although the Interim Contractual Milestones have been achieved, the project is not yet substantially or finally complete. Archer Western Contractors contend that the project is behind schedule due to either delays in receipt of owner supplied equipment or delays due to the City and/or their design consultant. The City has provided Archer Western Contractors an extensive punch list of items that must be completed prior to a final completion inspection. Staff projects that it will be late spring or early summer before the punch list is completed and the project is complete.

The work to be performed under this proposed amendment is for additional construction phase services

required due to the extended contract time required by Archer Western Contractors to complete the work The City will pursue reimbursement for this work from Archer Western Contractors Inc
