City Staff Task Force

- Create a City staff task force to implement these recommendations and research further enhancements
- Monitor 311 calls within the Downtown PID

<u>Litter Abatement</u>

- Install "Scoop the Poop" boxes
- Consider purchasing and installing ashtrays within the Downtown PID

Sidewalk Washing

- Provide a fact sheet to businesses for proper sidewalk washing
- Allow businesses the ability to use a water hose to wash sidewalks and alcoves
- Reconfigure East 6th Street irrigation system to provide water access to DAA
- Work with DAA to explore bird repellant solutions



Sidewalk Repair

- Repair sidewalks with DAA assistance for prioritizing
- Initiate an inventory of specialty sidewalk pavers that are maintained by the City
- Purchase the specialty pavers based on anticipated replacement need
- Develop a plan to replace the damaged specialty pavers

Alley Reconstruction

- Reconstruct five (5) Downtown alleys in 2007
- Plan to reconstruct two (2) Downtown alleys in 2008
- Plan to reconstruct two (2) Downtown alleys in 2007

Alley Cleanliness

- Investigate the feasibility of requiring businesses to label their grease traps barrels
- Explore implementing a City contract for a singleservice provider for grease collection
- Ensure that Waste Management replaces odorous and dirty dumpsters
- Finish implementing 2006 Sixth Street stakeholder meeting recommendations



Tree Grates

- Test a filter material placed underneath tree grates
- Install the filter material if successfully tested
- Install replacement tree grates

Bike Racks

 Implement an annual replacement program

<u>Traffic Signal Cabinets</u>

 Work with DAA to research using cabinets as an artist canvas

News Racks

- Have an initial meeting with periodical representatives to explain the goal for the pilot project and discuss options for program administration and invite comments
- Subject to the results of the initial meeting, proceed to implement a pilot program

Monuments and Works of Art

 Propose a plan and operating budget for the Great Streets streetscape maintenance that incorporates maintain monuments and works of art



Code Enforcement

- Provide two (2) additional inspectors within the Right-of-Way Management Division
- Provide one (1) additional sanitarian dedicated to Downtown restaurant inspections

<u>Awnings</u>

 Conduct a study for other enforcement means for having owners replace damaged awnings

ATMs

 Research whether the City can regulate ATMs



Completed Since October 2006

- Sidewalk Cleaning
 - Purchase a pressure washing machine with water recapture feature
- Litter Abatement
 - Purchase 12 ashtrays to be installed on East 6th Street
- Graffiti Removal
 - Assigned a full-time detective to work specifically on graffiti crimes
- Street Signs
 - Completely resigned Downtown area
- Littlefield Clock
 - Contacted owner to request repair and maintenance

- Sixth Street Urban Entertainment District Task Force
- ATM Regulation
- Storefront and Signage Design Guidelines
- Widening Sidewalks



Future Policy Decisions

- Installing Parking Meters on East 6th Street
- Barricade Installation and Removal Policy
- Street Vendor Fees
- Delivery Zones
