As representatives of CLB, the proposed developer of the above described property, we respectfully submit this letter to confirm the following

For its own reasons, constituting good and valuable consideration, in the event that CLB develops a project on the property which exceeds sixty (60) feet in height, CLB will make a contribution equal to Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the following parties, allocated as described below

- a Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) per entitled residential unit donated to Shoal Creek Greenway Improvements (Austin Parks Foundation), and
- Bemainder to be donated to either the Housing Trust Fund or the Smart Housing Capital Improvement Project Fund, or any other entity designated by the City of Austin whose primary purpose is to provide affordable housing

The contribution will be made upon the commencement of construction of the project
