

The Lance Armstrong Bikeway is a 6-mile-long bikeway that will start at the intersection of Lake Austin Boulevard and Veterans Drive and run east through downtown Austin to the Montopolis Bridge on the east side of Austin. In 2000, Council authorized funds for engineering for the project. The engineering for portions of the bikeway has been completed and construction should begin in April 2007. Construction is estimated to take approximately 300 days.

This amendment is to authorize the engineering necessary for the construction phase of the bikeway. In addition, the amendment authorizes the redesign of a short part of the bikeway. The part of the bikeway between Lamar and Seaholm may require some redesign due to possible conflicts with new development occurring in that area.
