# AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH NBC UNIVERSAL, INC, FOR THE TELEVISION PROGRAM "FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS"

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN**

**PART 1** The city council finds that

- (A) The City seeks to promote itself as a location for commercial film and television production, and to foster economic development and job creation in the film and television segment of the City's economy
- (B) The "Friday Night Lights" television program is an NBC television network dramatic series set in the context of the high school football environment, which is filmed in the Austin area, and the City desires that the program continue to be filmed in Austin
- (C) The filming of Friday Night Lights in the Austin vicinity helps to promote the City as a location for commercial television and film production
- (D) The Friday Night Lights production employs many Austin area residents, and NBC and its employees purchase goods and services in the Austin area
- (E) City support for the production of the Friday Night Lights program is an element of the economic development programs of the City
- (F) The grant of public funds provided in the Economic Development Agreement attached as Exhibit A, serves the City's goals of promoting economic development, stimulating local business and commercial activity, and elimination of unemployment and underemployment in the local television and film industry, all of which are public purposes of the City

**PARF 2** An economic development program for the Friday Night Lights television program is created under Texas Local Government Code Chapter 380 (*Miscellaneous Provisions Relating to Municipal Planning and Development*)

#### City of Austin and I riday Night Lights F conomic Development Agreement

STAIL OF IEXAS & COUNTY OF IRAVIS &

This Economic Development Agreement (Agreement) is entered into between the City of Austin a Texas home-rule municipality (Austin or City) and NBC Universal Inc. a Delaware corporation (NBC) acting on behalf of itself and its subsidiary Northern Entertainment Inc (FNE) pursuant to the authority granted in Chapter 380 Texas I ocal Government Code

WHLREAS the City seeks to foster economic development and job creation in the film and television segment of the City s economy and

WHLREAS the Friday Night I ights program (the 'program or programs') is an NBC television network dramatic scries set in the context of the high school football environment which is filmed in and around Austin and

WHEREAS the filming of Friday Night Lights in the Austin vicinity helps to promote the City as a location for commercial television and film production and

WHEREAS NBC FNL and their employees purchase goods and services in the Austin area and

WHEREAS NBC and FNI desire to work with the City to attain the City s economic development job creation goals in the film and television segment of the local economy and

WHERLAS City support for the production of the Friday Night I ights program as provided in this Agreement is an element of the economic development programs of the City and is intended to assist in the development of the City and State as a film and television production center and

WHERLAS the grant of public funds provided herein serves the City's goals of promoting local economic development stimulating local business and commercial activity and elimination of unemployment and underemployment in the television and film industry,

NOW IHLREFORE the City and NBC acting on behalf of itself and INL hereby agree to the following terms and conditions

- 1 <u>Findings</u> The above recitals are adopted as findings
- 2 <u>Phyment and Scope of Work</u> If the program is picked up or renewed for a second season by the NBC network the City agrees to pay an economic

development grant of \$40 000 to FNL provided however that this payment is conditioned on the requirement that the second season must be filmed and completed in the Austin area

After filming and completing a second season in the Austin arca in accordance with the requirements of this Agreement the City agrees to pav to FNL an additional economic development grant of \$40,000

Payments shall be made within 30 days after the City has reviewed the reports described in Section 6 below and has confirmed compliance with the requirements of this Agreement Payments are subject to annual appropriation in the City budget

For purposes of this Agreement a 'season' means twenty one (21) or more separate episodes intended to be broadcast on the NBC television network

For each subsequent season of the Program filmed in the Austin area in accordance with the requirements of this Agreement the City agrees to pay to FNL an additional economic development grant calculated according to the tollowing formula

Fifty percent (50%) of the sum of A) City sales and use taxes paid, B) City fees paid and C) \$95 per employee In calculating the number of employees for this purpose employees shall include residents and nonresidents of the Austin Metropolitan Statistical Area (AMSA') and shall be based on the average weekly number of total employees

- 3 <u>Employees</u> Over the course of filming a season the FNL series will vary in staffing from one episode to the next and from one day to the next Staffing for cast, crew and extras are dictated by script requirements NBC will hire or cause its contractors to hire a minimum of seventy five percent\_of its cast crew and extras from residents of the Austin Metropolitan Statistical Area (AMSA) per episode. The AMSA is depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A Staffing levels will vary between two hundred and seven hundred individuals per episode. NBC shall keep at least seventy five percent of all such positions filled with residents of the AMSA during the time required to complete filming of each season. For purposes of this section employee requirements do not include or apply to incillarly support services or contractors over which NBC does not exercise personnel hiring authority, including but not limited to dry cleaning catering and equipment rental services.
- 4 <u>Credits</u> NBC agrees to place the credits of each program episode of the second scason the following message Filmed on location in Austin Texas USA or a similar statement placement to be at the producer's discretion

- 5 <u>I ocal Purchases</u> NBC agrees to continue to use commercially reasonable efforts to purchase or acquire goods and services related to program production in the Austin area
- 6 <u>Report</u> An annual report verified by an NBC official is due on or before sixty (60) days following the end of production filming The report shall be on a form provided by the Citv and shall verify that (a) filming of a season has been completed (b) the required number of Austin area employees were hired and maintained throughout the season (c) NBC purchased goods and services locally and (d) the statement required by Section 4 is or will appear in the program credits

Compliance with the employment and local purchases of goods and services requirements may be established by submission of a redacted copy of NBC s final expenditure budget showing the number of employees payroll information and local goods and services expenditures — The City may audit records of NBC solely for the purpose of confirming compliance with these requirements

- 7 <u>Insurance</u> NBC Universal Inc maintains insurance covering Friday Night Fights' under the following policies. Comprehensive General Liability Automobile Liability Workers Compensation Frrois and Omissions and All Risk Property For the General Liability policy the City of Austin shall be included as additional insured per ISO Endorsement CG2010 in the amount of \$5 000 000, Combined Single Limit
- 8 <u>Term</u> The term of this Agreement shall be from March 22 2007 through the cancellation of the series unless otherwise terminated by initial agreement of the parties
- 9 <u>Communication</u> All communications with the City initially shall be directed to Sue Edwards Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office City of Austin P O Box 1088 Austin Texas 78767

All communication with NBC initially shall be directed to Andrew Fossett Counsel NBC Universal Inc. 30 Rockefeller Plaza New York NY 10112

Lither party may designate a different address at any time upon written notice to the other party

10 Entire Agreement, Amendment This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and may be amended only by in agreement in writing signed by the parties hereto. All prior or contemporaneous understandings and agreements related to the subject matter hereof are merged herein.

11 <u>No Assignment</u> This Agreement is not assignable



- 12 <u>Defult</u> It either the City or NBC should default in the performance of any obligations of the Agreement the other party shall provide such defaulting party written notice of the default and a minimum period of thirty (30) days to cure such default prior to instituting an action for breach or pursuing any other remedy for default
- 13 <u>Iermination</u> In the event that NBC does not proceed to complete filming of a season (as defined in Section 2 above) in the Austin area during the term of this Agreement NBC shall notify the City in writing and this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and neither party shall have any further obligations hereunder, save and except for the continuation of NBC s obligation under Section 16 below to indemnify and defend the City against claims that may arise prior to termination
- 14 <u>Applicable Law</u> This Agreement is made and shall be construed and interpreted under the laws of the State of Lexas ind venue shall lie in the State courts of Travis County Texas
- 15 No Third Party Beneficiaries, No Joint Venture. It is acknowledged and agreed by the parties that the terms of this Agreement are not intended to and shall not be deemed to create any partnership or joint venture among the parties and further that the Agreement does not confer any rights privileges or causes of action upon any third party. The Citv its past present and future officers elected officials employees, and agents do not assume any responsibilities or habilities to any third party in connection with the operations and activities of NBC. Northern Entertainment Inc or their affiliates subsidiaries employees officers agents and contractors.
- 16 <u>Indemnification</u> NBC agrees to indemnify defend and hold harmless the City of Austin its past present and future officers officials employees and agents from and against any and all claims or causes of action arising in part or entirely from the actions errors or omissions of NBC or any of their affiliates subsidiaries employees officers agents or contractors related to the program
