WHEREAS, the City of Austin has the benefit of a multi-year study addressing Board and Commission effectiveness; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the governing body of the City:

1. wishes to affirm that the City of Austin Board and Commission system plays a vital role in our form of government; and
2. wishes to ensure that the City of Austin Board and Commission system operates as effectively as possible; and
3. wishes to ensure that the Board and Commission system is enhanced by a review process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:


That the City Manager is directed to review the attached draft ordinance and report back to Council in 90 days with comments and recommendations on the following points:

2. policy issues included in the draft ordinance; and
3. a timeline and suggested process for implementing Board and Commission system revisions as described in the draft ordinance; and

4. any costs associated with implementation or ongoing administration of the attached draft ordinance.
