

RESOLUTION NO. 20070405-029

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council establishes a Charter Revision Committee composed of seven members who are representative of the community. Each council member shall recommend one Committee member who will be appointed by the City Council.


The Committee shall advise the City Council on proposed amendments to the City Charter related to geographical representation for the election of council members. In particular, the Committee shall review and report on the advisability of a charter amendment proposing single member districts or a representation scheme that includes both single member and at-large council seats for council member elections.

The Committee shall begin its work as soon as all members are appointed and shall work expeditiously with the goal of recommending amendments for consideration by the City Council within 180 days. The City Council may expand the scope of work for the Committee by resolution.

The City Manager shall provide appropriate resources to the Charter Committee.
