RESOLUTION NO. 20070419-003

WHEREAS, individual governmental entities within the State of Texas operate various public safety and public service wireless communication systems; and

WHEREAS, the governmental entities recognize the need for interagency communication, interoperability, and cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the governmental entities using these systems are becoming more interdependent, and would benefit from statewide integration of these systems and shared information flow; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that it is time to participate with other governmental entities to consider and plan for a statewide wireless interoperable communication system composed of existing or future local and regional radio systems that are under local control; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative effort between these government entities is necessary to facilitate financing, planning, and development of a statewide wireless interoperable communication system; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- 1. The City may cooperate with other participating governments to establish the Texas Radio Coalition to plan and develop a statewide wireless interoperable communication system composed of existing or future local and regional systems under local control.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to take action necessary to pursue this goal including:
 - (a) assigning appropriate staff to attend Texas Radio Coalition and other meetings to develop a plan for a statewide wireless interoperable communication system;
 - (b) identifying funding that may be available for this cooperative intergovernmental project, including federal, state, local, or private grant funds; and

(c)	informing the City Council about planning, funding, and other
	information relevant to policy and budget decisions related to
	participation and implementation of the Texas Radio Coalition.
