BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for \$442,211 in grant funding from the Texas Department of Transportation, Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority, for the continuation of the Auto Theft Interdiction Project in the Austin Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for grant renewal funds for said project in the amount of \$442,211 from the Texas Department of Transportation, Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority, for the continuation of the Auto Theft Interdiction Project in the Austin Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and


