RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION****Item No. 8**

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**Subject:** Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the co-sponsorship agreement between the City and the Urban Life Group, Inc., in the amount of \$25,000 to produce the rescheduled second day of the 2007 Urban Music Festival on June 23, 2007 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$69,000.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Operating Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department.

**Fiscal Note:** There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

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The 2007 Urban Music Festival (UMF) is an outdoor, family-oriented music event held on Auditorium Shores. UMF is one of the City's co-sponsored African American Quality of Life Initiatives that showcases and celebrates the musical contributions of local, regional and nationally accomplished African - American artists.

This is an amendment to the Agreement to Co-Sponsorship of the Urban Music Festival and Use of Park Facilities, entered into on August 15, 2006. Given that this year's two-day 2007 Urban Music Festival, originally scheduled to take place April 6-7, 2007 was adversely affected by inclement weather and that the second day of the event (April 7, 2007) was ultimately postponed as a result, the City desires to co-sponsor with Urban Life Group, Inc., the rescheduling of the second day on June 23, 2007, as the culminating event for the City's annual Juneteenth Celebration.
