

Bid documents were distributed to two general contractors. However, only one bidder attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting April 19, 2007 and was eligible to submit a bid. Bids were opened May 3, 2007. Viking Construction is the sole bidder for this project. The bid is very close to the Engineer's Estimate and appears to be a reasonable price for the project.

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for five areas of subcontracting opportunities: crack sealing and hot mix surface replacement, hauling aggregate, supply of asphalt emulsion, supply of aggregates, and thermoplastic striping of streets.

Participation goals stated in the solicitation were 12.90% MBE and 12.60% WBE. Total Participation estimated on base bid amount of \$1,610,068.35
