Subject: Approve a resolution authorizing the fee simple acquisition of Lot 10, Block M, resubdividion of lots 11, 12, 13, and 14, of Block H and lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of Block M Onion Creek Forest, Section 4, Amended Plat, a subdivision in Travis County, Texas, located at 7101 Onion Crossing Drive, from Jesus and Betania Anicua for the Onion Creek Voluntary Flood Buyout-FEMA 1606-DR Project for the land and improvements for a total amount not to exceed \$120,000.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Capital Budget of the Watershed Protection and Development Review Department.

On July 27, 2006, Council approved and accepted \$6,255,823 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Onion Creek Voluntary Flood Buyout-FEMA-1606-DR Project. The purpose of the project is to purchase and demolish up to 118 single-family structures in the floodplain of Onion Creek, an area significantly impacted during the floods of October 17, 1998 and November 15, 2001, and maintain the land as open space. The property and residence located at 7101 Onion Crossing Drive are part of the approved grant program.

The lot to be acquired is approximately 0.28 acres with improvements that include a 1,185 square-foot single-family dwelling. The market value of the property including improvements is \$120,000, as determined by independent appraisal. The owner has agreed to accept the City's offer.
