### Item 12: Mandatory Interview

### 25 points maximum

The number of Proposers invited to interview will depend on the scores following evaluation of the written submittal responses. Staff will consider significant gaps in point separation between the top ranked Proposers in determining the number of Proposers to be interviewed. Only Proposers that are considered, on the basis of their written submittal responses, qualified to perform the work will be invited for interviews. No more than five Proposers will be interviewed.
