**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Capital Budgets and/or Operating Budgets of the various departments for which services are needed.

**Fiscal Note:** There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

**MBE/WBE:** This contract was awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9B of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) with 5.59% MBE and 3.03% WBE sub-consultant participation to date.

**Prior Council Action:** 02/12/04 Surveying Services Rotation List in the amount of \$2,650,000 was approved.

On October 17, 2003, 18 firms were selected for the 2003-2005 Surveying Services Rotation List with a total authorization in the amount of \$2,650,000. This Rotation List was established to provide professional land surveying services for the City of Austin to achieve its Capital Improvement Program and facility design and construction objectives. To date, there have been 144 projects of varying scopes assigned to the 18 firms for a total contract expenditure of approximately \$2,302,595.00

This Request for Council Action is for the approval of an additional \$500,000 in authorization under the 2003-2005 Surveying Services Rotation List. This requested authorization is expected to enable the Rotation List firms to complete the remaining services and maintain required project continuity until the new rotation list is in effect. The RFQ evaluation process for the new rotation list is currently underway. It is anticipated that the RCA for the new 2007-2009 Surveying Rotation List will reach Council by late August 2007.
