ORDINANCE NO. 20070621-069

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 12-4-24 OF THE CITY CODE TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE AREA BOUNDED BY WEST 29TH STREET, GUADALUPE STREET, WEST 24TH STREET, AND NORTH LAMAR BOULEVARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-24 (*Maximum Speed of 25 Miles Per Hour*) of the City Code is amended to add the following streets:

24th ¹/₂ Street (West) between Rio Grande Street and Seton Avenue.

25th Street (West) between Lamar Boulevard (North) and Rio Grande Street.

28th ¹/₂ Street (West) between Rio Grande Street and Shoal Crest Avenue.

Hume Place between Guadalupe Street and 26th Street (West).

Odom Street between San Pedro Street and the end of Odom Street.

Pearl Street between 25th Street (West) and 26th Street (West).

Pearl Street between 29th Street (West) and the end of Pearl Street.

Salado Street between 26th Street (West) and 29th Street (West).

San Gabriel Street between Lamar Boulevard (North) and 29th Street (West).

Seton Avenue between 24th Street (West) and 25th Street (West).

Shoal Cliff Court between San Pedro Street and the end of Shoal Cliff Court.

PART 2. The City Council finds that the prima facie speed limit previously applicable to the streets, or portions of streets, identified in Part 1 of this ordinance is unreasonable or unsafe, and the reduction in speed limit on these streets will reduce the potential for vehicle-pedestrian accidents.

PART 3. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on July 2, 2007.
