- 5 Set a public hearing to receive input on the issuance of private activity volume cap multi-family non-recourse bonds, in an amount not to exceed \$12,000,000, to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of the Runnymede Apartments, 1101 Rutland Drive, Austin, TX, to be owned and operated by a single-purpose, Texas limited partnership affiliated with SAN ANTONIO ALTERNATIVE HOUSING CORPORATION, a Texas non-
