



Austin City Council MINUTES

For SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - AUGUST 15, 1989 - 6:00 P.M.

Council Chambers, 307 West Second Street, Austin, Texas

Mayor Cooke called to order the meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmember Urdy. Mayor Cooke announced the purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing on the arts funding for 1989-90.

(6-0 Vote, Councilmember Urdy absent.)
