## Police RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

**Subject:** Authorize negotiation and execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Austin Independent School District (AISD) for space on school premises for the City of Austin Eastside Story-Austin Police Department (APD) after-school program and summer camp in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the initial period of one (1) year with the option to renew for four successive one (1) year terms; total costs of the Agreement not to exceed \$25,000 if all renewal options are exercised.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding in the amount of \$25,000 for the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This agreement is for the use of space in AISD schools for the APD Eastside Story program and related janitorial supplies. The Eastside Story program is a community based policing program that provides youth services to elementary and middle school students living in Central and North East Austin. The primary focus of the program is to provide a safe after school environment while promoting educational success and personal development through tutoring and enrichment services. The after school program serves over 450 students from October to May in nine (9) schools and the 6 week summer program serves 250 students The program has been an integral service to students and parents for after school care. It serves as a platform for community partnerships and for APD employee volunteers, both sworn and civilian, to interface with the community.
