5 **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS IN**
6 **THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; CREATING**
7 **CERTAIN POSITIONS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 20070726-028**
8 **RELATING TO POLICE DEPARTMENT CLASSIFICATIONS AND**
9 **POSITIONS.**

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

13 **PART 1.** The Council finds:

- 14 (A) The City adopted Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143 (*Municipal*
15 *Civil Service*), which applies to members of the classified service in the Police
16 Department.
- 17 (B) Chapter 143 (*Municipal Civil Service*) provides that the City Council shall
18 establish the classifications for the Police Department and the number of
19 positions in each classification.
- 20 (C) The Police Department recommends the creation of certain classified positions
21 to improve the delivery of police services and increase efficiency in the Police
22 Department.

23 **PART 2.** The following civil service classifications of the Police Department and the
24 number of positions in each classification are established as follows:

- 25 (A) Assistant Chief 5
26 (B) Commander 19
27 (C) Police Lieutenant 58
28 (D) Police Sergeant 151
29 (E) Police Detective 288
30 (F) Police Corporal 72
31 (G) Police Officer 922
32

PART 3. The number of positions in the classification of Police Officer in Part 2 of this ordinance is an increase of seventy-three from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance.

PART 4. The Base Salary Schedules attached to the Meet and Confer Agreement ratified on March 26, 2004, are adopted for each civil service classification except Assistant Chief.

PART 5. Ordinance No. 20070726-028 is repealed.
