This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$25,437,197 for 10 3%, and of that amount \$8,582,677 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year

As of the date the proposed budget went to print, the City of Austin had not yet received its certified appraisal rolls from the chief appraisers of the Travis Central and Williamson County Appraisal Districts, therefore the amounts above are estimates and may change ·门路 管 · · ··· The amounts above are based on the City's estimate of its proposed fiscal year 2007 08 tax rate of 41+20 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. The City's fiscal year 2006 07 tax rate (the current tax rate) is 41 26 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation The City has since received the certified tax'roll "Because the assessed valuations were higher than anticipated the highest tax rate that the City will consider for FY-2007 2008 is 40 34 cents The additional revenue will pay for the increased cost of the same operations that were funded in this current year and will also fund the restoration of services such as parks maintenance and library materials that were cut back in recent years, and additional emergency medical services and health and human services 😿
