



Together in one year we have...

- Provided low-cost and free spay/neuter for 28,934 animals
- Provided low-cost or free heartworm treatment for 349 animals
- Provided 470 low-cost or free life saving surgeries
- Provided low-cost wellness care for 18,397 animals
- Adopted/Transferred 9,194 animals into new homes
- Returned 3,234 animals to their owners
- Provided hundreds of humane education programs for schools and community groups

- Spay/Neuter Feral Fix Program at Austin Humane, Free Vouchers Provided by Town Lake Animal Center for Feral Cats, Targeted Low Cost Spay/Neuter & Microchips
- Capacity Building Animal Trustees of Austin Capital Campaign, Dialogue Education Training, Board Development, AISD School Program, Habitat for Humanity

- 8.38% increase in animal adoptions






Levander Loop Site
