Related Goals

Prevention: Health Services – Prevent the spread of communicable disease and reduce the risk of health complications due to disease and unhealthy behaviors.

- Provide health assessments to 100% of the refugees arriving or moving to the program service area.
- Document and report a minimum of 75% of referral outcomes.
- Initiate screening services within ninety (90) days of refugees' arrival in the United States.
- Complete each Refugee Health Assessment Form for 100% of the referred refugees arriving or moving to the program service area, and return form to the Texas Department of State Health Services Refugee Health Screening Program within thirty (30) days of providing screening services.
- Submit biannual reports to the Texas Department of State Health Services Refugee Health Screening Program.
