**Public Hearings and Possible Actions
RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION****Item No. 84**

Subject: Conduct a public hearing and consider an amendment to Chapter 25-6 of the City Code, relating to sidewalks, to include a new variance process, new building permit requirements, and proposed fee-in-lieu process.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by the Planning Commission.

Currently sidewalks are only required with new subdivisions or site plans. This amendment specifies that sidewalks may be required at the time a building permit is issued for new construction or a major addition to an existing structure. The amendment also allows an applicant in certain cases to contribute to a sidewalk fund in lieu of constructing a required sidewalk. Additionally, it makes all waivers from sidewalk requirements administrative. At present a waiver may be granted administratively if requested with a site plan but must be approved by the Land Use Commission if requested with a subdivision.
