RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION****Item No. 10**

Subject: Approve execution of a contract with KEYSTONE CONSTRUCTION INC. for replacement of the Zilker Park Irrigation Pump Station, in the amount of \$327,000 for the Base Bid, with no alternates for a total approval amount of \$327,000.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding is available in the Fiscal Year 2007- 2008 Capital Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department.

MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9A of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) by meeting the goals with 13.76% MBE and 13.15% WBE subcontractor participation.

This project is to provide a replacement of the irrigation pump station for Zilker Park. The goal of PARD is to continue to strive to use lake water or other alternative water re-use solutions where possible, for irrigation purposes.

This contractor will supply and install a prefabricated irrigation pump station complete with intake line and main line connection. Completion of this project will allow for the conversion from potable to raw water from Lady Bird Lake for irrigating the entire north end of Zilker Park. The project is estimated to be completed in 165 calendar days, weather permitting.
