

**RESOLUTION NO 20070927-052**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted a funding plan as part of the FY 2006-07 budget that allocated \$1 million to Holly Neighborhood Programs, and

**WHEREAS**, \$250,000 of the funds allocated to such items as After School Programs and Cultural Arts Projects have not been used, and

**WHEREAS**, the Holly Neighborhood Home Rehabilitation Program managed by the City Neighborhood Housing and Community Development Program has been extremely effective and well received by the residents, **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN**

That the City Council reallocates \$230,000 of the remaining funds in the Holly Good Neighbor Program to the Holly Neighborhood Home Rehabilitation Program, and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**

That the remaining \$20,000 in Holly Good Neighbor Program funds will be allocated as follows

- \$15,000 to Baile Folklórico (i.e., Ballet East Dance Company) for an after-school dance program at Metz and Sanchez Elementary Schools, and
- \$5,000 to the Austin Public Library Foundation (c/o Cepeda Music Garden Project) for "Rock y Roll Día 2007" to be held November 2, 2007
