**Subject:** Approve an ordinance amending Section 12-4-64(D) of the City Code by adding a portion of Avery Ranch Boulevard to the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 40 miles per hour at all times.

In order to modify or alter the existing prima facie speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. An investigation was conducted by the Transportation Division of the Public Works Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, November 2006.
