

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES FOR  
TEMPORARY VENDING PERMITS FOR THE GREEN CORN PROJECT  
AUTUMN CELEBRATION HELD AT THE BOGGY CREEK FARM.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The Council finds that the Green Corn Project is a nonprofit corporation, and the Autumn Celebration is open to the public and serves the public purpose of promoting a healthy environment by reducing the use of toxic materials in gardening, and the celebration provides a family friendly civic activity.

**PART 2.** Council authorizes reimbursement of fees for City of Austin Health & Human Services Department temporary vending permits for the Green Corn Project Autumn Celebration held on October 21, 2007 at Boggy Creek Farm in an amount not exceed \$735.
