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ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING AND ALTERING THE FULL PURPOSE
BOUNDARY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN BY TRANSFERRING
APPROXIMATELY 1 ACRE OF LAND FROM THE CITY OF CEDAR PARK
TO THE CITY OF AUSTIN IN ACCORDANCE WITH TEXAS LOCAL
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 43.031.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that:

- (A) Texas Local Government Code Section 43.031 authorizes adjacent cities to make mutually agreeable changes to their boundaries of areas that are less than 1,000 feet in width.
- (B) The proposed boundary adjustment will bring the entire intersection of Lakeline Boulevard and U.S. Hwy 183 into Austin's full purpose city limits. It will eliminate potential confusion over jurisdiction related to emergency response, enforcement of public safety regulations and maintenance of signs, signals, and striping.
- (C) The City of Austin has requested the boundary adjustment approved by this ordinance, and the City of Cedar Park has agreed to it.

PART 2. The full purpose corporate limits of the City of Austin are amended to include the following tract:

A tract of land containing approximately 1 acre of land out of the Rachel Saul Survey, Abstract 551 in Williamson County, Texas, said 1 acre of land being more particularly described in Exhibit A.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on _____, 2007.
