AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES FOR TEMPORARY VENDING PERMITS FOR THE GREEN CORN PROJECT AUTUMN CELEBRATION HELD AT THE BOGGY CREEK FARM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that the Green Corn Project is a nonprofit corporation, and the Autumn Celebration is open to the public and serves the public purpose of promoting a healthy environment by reducing the use of toxic materials in gardening, and the celebration provides a family friendly civic activity

PART 2. Council authorizes reimbursement of fees for City of Austin Health & Human Services Department temporary vending permits for the Green Corn Project Autumn Celebration held on October 21, 2007 at Boggy Creek Farm in an amount not exceed \$735

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on November 12, 2007
