## Purchasing Office RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

**Subject:** Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with W-S INDUSTRIAL SERIVCES, INCORPORATED, Council Bluff, IA, for the cleaning of condenser tubes, cooling systems, and heat exchangers at Austin Energy power stations in an estimated amount not to exceed \$266,682, with one 36-month extension option in an estimated amount not to exceed \$266,682 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$533,364.

**Amount and Source of Funding:** Funding in the amount of \$74,079 is available in the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining 26 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

**MBE/WBE:** This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9C of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide services for hydro cleaning of condenser tubes, cooling systems, and heat exchangers at Austin Energy's power stations. Hydro cleaning is a method of removing build-up such as silt, algae, clamshells, and calcium that has accumulated from river water use. This cleaning service is essential to reduce and prevent future build-up, which reduces the efficiency of the generating units.
