Subject: Approve an ordinance to annex the Barton Creek Greenbelt annexation area for full purposes (approximately 35 acres in Travis County at the southeast corner of Loop 360 and Loop 1); and approve a service plan.

Prior Council Action: Public Hearings were held on October 11 and October 18, 2007.

The Barton Creek Greenbelt Annexation Area (approximately 35 acres) is located in Travis County at the southeast corner of Loop 360 and Loop 1. This area is currently in the city's limited purpose jurisdiction (annexed 07/21/83 and 02/02/84) and is adjacent to the full purpose city limits on all or portions of four sides. The area includes the remaining portion of the Barton Creek Greenbelt not already in the city's full purpose jurisdiction. City service departments requested full purpose annexation to ensure dispatch of appropriate public safety agencies.
