

ORDINANCE NO. 20071108-049

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-64(D) OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF SOUTH CONGRESS AVENUE TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED OF 20 MILES PER HOUR IN A PEDESTRIAN ZONE DURING CERTAIN TIMES OF THE DAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:




PART 1. Section 12-4-64 (D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add a portion of South Congress Avenue to the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 20 miles per hour in a pedestrian zone during certain times of the day as indicated by a flashing light, as follows:

South Congress Avenue from 135 feet south of Nellie Street to 255 feet north of Annie Street. [20 miles per hour]

PART 2. This amendment shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on November 19, 2007.
