WHEREAS the Resource Management Commission supports the need for increased water conservation; and

WHEREAS the installation of high efficiency toilets is an important tool in reducing long term water use with an average reduction of 5,814 gallons per year per toilet; and

WHEREAS by offering toilets at no cost to customers, participation in the Water Conservation Toilet Replacement Program will increase; and

WHEREAS increasing water efficiency saves customers money, reduces energy usage, and benefits the environment through increased stream flows and reduced air pollution;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Resource Management Commission recommends the authorization of the award and execution of a 24-month supply agreement with Ferguson Enterprises, Inc. for high efficiency toilets for qualified retail customers of the Austin Water Utility.
