

ORDINANCE NO. 20071213-043

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-64(D) OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF SOUTH PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MILES PER HOUR DURING CERTAIN TIMES IN A SCHOOL ZONE FOR PEREZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add the following street section to the list of streets with a maximum speed of 20 miles per hour during certain times in a school zone:

Pleasant Valley Road (South) from 100 feet south of Quicksilver Boulevard to Edge Creek Drive (Perez Elementary School).

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order in Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*).

PART 3. Council finds that school is in session, and this constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
