RESOLUTION NO. 20071206-007

WHEREAS, Council has adopted water conservation strategies to reach its goal of reducing peak day water use by 1 percent per year for 10 years; and

WHEREAS, a task force to review progress and recommend changes or adjustments to the water conservation strategies will aid in reaching the peak day water reduction goal; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- 1. The Citizen's Water Conservation Implementation Task Force ("Task Force") is created to advise the Resource Management Commission and City Council on matters related to implementation of the water conservation strategies adopted by Resolution No. 20070503-029.
- 2. The Task Force shall consist of 15 members, appointed by City Council for a term of two (2) years. Six members shall be "atlarge" and nine members shall include representatives of the following stakeholder groups:
 - irrigators
 - large governmental users
 - large industrial users
 - environmental advocates
 - development advocates

- commercial property management companies
- multi-family developments
- restaurants
- hotels
- 3. The Task Force shall meet quarterly or as needed, and present its findings and recommendations to the Resource Management Commission on a regular basis.
- 4. The Task Force shall report to the City Council as needed.
- 5. The Task Force shall terminate on December 6, 2010.
