

# ATI – a program of UT-Austin's IC<sup>2</sup> Institute





### Historical impact since 1989

- 150+ graduate companies
- >\$720 million in capital raised
- 4 IPOs
- >25 acquisitions
- >30 independent, profitable companies
- \$1.5 billion in revenue
- Estimated 10,000 jobs (direct and indirect) created by ATI companies
- Hundreds of UT students trained in technology entrepreneurship

# 2006/07 overall impact – economic development

- >25 companies supported
- >100 total jobs
- >\$6 million investor capital raised
- >70% funding success rate (2006 class)
- 4 (potentially 5) companies received Texas
   Emerging Technology Fund committee approval
- 3 successful relocation efforts
- >75 companies in pipeline

# 2006/07 return on City's Wireless investment

- City investment in ATI Wireless (FY 06/07) = \$200,000
- Capital investment in ATI Wireless companies
  - FY 06/07 = \$1.3M (6.5:1 leverage on City's ATI Wireless investment)
  - FY 05/06 thru FY 06/07 = \$7.4M (18.5:1 leverage)

### Company pipeline

- >40 evaluated in ATI Wireless pipeline
- 4 new members
- 4 new graduates

### Job creation

- FY 06/07 = 17 net new jobs (high skill/pay positions), ~50 total jobs
- Historically, companies launched at ATI create an average of 60 jobs as they grow

# 2006/07 return on City's CEI investment

- City investment in CEI (FY 06/07) = \$220,000
  - \$120,000 for Clean Energy Venture Summit
    - 420 attended, 20 companies presented, national participation
  - \$100,000 to support CEI core mission
- Capital investment in CEI companies
  - FY 06/07 = \$3.0M (13.6:1 leverage on City's CEI investment)
- Company pipeline
  - >80 evaluated in CEI pipeline
  - 5 new members
  - 5 new graduates
- Job creation
  - FY 06/07 = 18 net new jobs (high skill/pay positions), ~50 total jobs
  - Historically, companies launched at ATI create an average of 60 jobs as they grow
