Austin Energy RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Subject: Approve a three-year membership with POWER ACROSS TEXAS, Austin, TX, a non-profit organization, to partner with Austin Energy in providing research and analysis to advance environmentally sound approaches for ensuring reliable power supplies at the lowest possible price for all Texans in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 over three years.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$25,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining \$50,000 is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.
