PC supports the AHITF and staff recommendations. Furthermore, whereas there is concern that the fixed fee-in-lieu-of value equal to \$10/sf may be affected by inflation or market conditions the PC recommends the following:

- 1. City staff should examine the recent data collected under the Downtown Plan Phase 1 to estimate current market variables, should examine information that will collected under the housing market study, and should use economic models to verify or change the fixed fee-in-lieu-of value;
- 2. City should consider indexing the fee-in-lieu-of value to a cost of living indicator;
- 3. City should annually report the fee-in-lieu-of value to the City Council during public hearings.

In addition, whereas there is concern that work is going on coincidentally with the Downtown Plan, the Design Commission's Density Bonus proposal, VMU roll-out, and the AHITF recommendation implementation, the PC recommends explicit efforts be made to bring about congruence to ensure these initiatives do not conflict with each other.
