 - Who
 - Why



Partnership: Roles and Responsibilities

APD

- Identify locations
- Assist with logistics & planning process
- Utilize District Reps to support survey process

HHSD

- Coordinate with stakeholders and planning groups
- Secure technical expert -Assist in survey process
- Help with analysis

Technical Expert

- Design survey methodology and questionnaire
- Select & train interviewers
- Supervise survey process
- Supervise follow-up process with focus groups
- Analyze data



Timeline

March	 Contract with outside (university) expert Initial development of the survey and strategies
April	 Stakeholder meeting and solicitor focus group meeting/individual interviews Finalize the survey questionnaire/instrument Identify locations
April to mid- May	 Recruit interviewers Design database Community education/outreach about the survey
May	Training for interviewers/APD Staff
June	Beginning of Survey Period, & review of survey documents & process
July to mid-August	Analyze information and develop report
August	Report to the City Council
September	Completion of Survey/Plan Activities

Survey Content

- Survey topics may include:
 - Demographic and Family Information
 - Living Situation
 - Reasons for Solicitation
 - Duration/Frequency of Panhandling, and etc.
- A final decision by the research team on the survey design will be reviewed by APD, HHSD, and stakeholders



Cost Estimate

Design questionnaire, supervise survey process, and analyze	\$25,000
Interviewers	\$15,500
Remuneration/incentives	\$ 2,500
Miscellaneous unidentified costs	\$ 5,000
Total Estimated Costs	\$48,000
