WHEREAS, the City of Austin has committed to constructing the Waller Creek Tunnel; and

WHEREAS, this tunnel, a CIP project, will be funded through dedicated venue bonds and the Waller Creek TIF, in partnership with Travis County; and

WHEREAS, the Waller Creek TIF necessitates the need to maximize developable land; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, recognizing the aging conditions of the current location of the Austin Police Department Main Headquarters, has already authorized relocating the Municipal Court from the Austin Police Department Main Headquarters Building; and

WHEREAS, the City of Austin is currently planning a new substation for the Austin Police Department that will house the North Central and North East Area Commands; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council directs the City Manager to evaluate the feasibility of locating those Austin Police Department operations currently housed at the Austin Police Department Main Headquarters building to the planned substation that will house the North Central and North East Area Commands, or to other appropriate locations, and report back to Council in 90 days.
