I herewith submit to you my report as to improvement upon the alley between Congress Avenue and Colorado street , from the north line of 3rd street to the south line of 4th street and from the north line of 4th street to the south line of 5th street as follows, to-wit:

I estimate the total cost of the said improvements in accordance with the contract and specifications therefor at the sum of \$1,525.96 I estimate the cost of said improvements to owners of abutting property per front foot of such abutting property at \$1,782.

The above estimates include excavation to the depth of six (4) inches, this being the thickness of the Dolarway pavement, and any additional exca--vation to be paid for by the City.

Contlemen :

. I herewith submit to tau my report as to improvements upon the alley between Congress Avenue and Brazos street , from the north line of third street to the south line of fourth street and from the north line of fourth street to the south line of fifth dtreet as, follows, to-wit:

I estimate the total cost of said improvements in a coordance with the contract and specifications therefor at the sum of $3.1,525.9 \, l_0$

I estimate the cost of said improvements to owners of abutting property per front foot of surch abutting property at \$ \$ 1,382.00.
