Whereas, said Rockdale Lignite Co has asked to be relieved from its contract to furnish the City of Austin with Lignite for the Water, Light and Power Plant for the balance of the year 1912, and Messrs Ryan and Perry of Rockdale, Texas, hasve signified their willingness to carry out the contract with certain qualifications; Now therefore,

Resolved that the Supt of Parks and Public Property be authorized to contract with Messas Ryan and Perry for Lignite for the city of Austin, Texas, for the year commencing August 15th 1912, and ending August 15th 1913, at \$1.35 per ton f o b Austin, Texas, under similar contract to thet with the Rockdale Lignite co; with the provise that when the city of Austin can receive power from the dam now being erected across the colorado River above the city of Austin, it shall not be obligated to take only such lignite as shall be required for additional power; and provided also that the city of Austin shall have the option of extending the contract for Lignite with Messas Ryan & Ferry until Jan 1st 1914, upon the same terms by giving the said Ryan & Perry notice of such lesired extension 50 days before the expiration of the proposed contract.
