RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Subject: Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with URS CORPORATION, A NEVADA CORPORATION, Austin, Texas for engineering services for Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) East Runway System Perimeter Road Construction in the amount of \$200,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$545,158.04.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$200,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Capital Budget of the Aviation Department.

MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 (Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program) and Chapter 2-9B of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) with 15.39% DBE subconsultant participation to date.

Boards and Commission Action: Recommended by the Austin Airport Advisory Commission.

Prior Council Action: May 27, 2004: City Council approved a request for a professional services contract with URS CORPORATION, A NEVADA CORPORATION.

September 29, 2005: City Council approved a request for an amendment to the professional services contract with URS CORPORATION, A NEVADA CORPORATION.

February 28, 2008: City Council approved a request for a construction contract with Austin Bridge and Road, LP.

The purpose of this project is to provide a complete East Runway System Perimeter Road along the south end of Runway 17L/35R. The project is currently in the construction phase and the construction contract in the amount of \$2,406,505, has been awarded to Austin Bridge and Road, LP. The selected consultant has completed the Preliminary Engineering Report phase, the Design phase and the Bidding/Award phase of the project. The current contract with the consultant includes the Construction Administration Services phase and an initial portion of the Resident Project Representative (RPR) services. This request is for the addition of RPR Services to the consultant's Professional Services Agreement. The RPR acts as the engineer's agent on site and provides construction management and oversight to ensure the quality of the work and conformance with the construction documents.

The anticipated dates of work are approximately June 2008 through March 2009. The contract allows for 265 calendar days for final completion.
