WHEREAS, proceeds from the ATX Music Festival will benefit the Tejano Music Museum, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation based in Austin, and


WHEREAS, the City Council has identified the ATX Music Festival as a project to be funded through the Holly Good Neighbor "Cultural Arts" Projects,
